WAKE UP, PETERHEAD!

The controversy over the question of dumping German caught fish in British ports has raised a number of questions which have hitherto been allowed to lie in abeyance, and it will be a good thing to give a few of them an airing.

The main objection against permitting German trawlers to land their fish at British ports is, a sentimental one, colored partly by the racial hatred that still subsists between our people and the Teuton. We have neither forgotten nor forgiven the German barbarities of the war, and even at the risk of losing a little advantage by selling to ourselves, we are not yet prepared to receive Fritz as a friend.

Naturally the trawler skipper and fishermen of our coast object to German competition, and have raised a bitter cry against it. But the skippers and fishermen do not constitute the bulk and end-all of trawling fishery.

When there is a brisk demand in the home market for fish, and the local crews are unable to land supplies sufficient to meet the demand, it is in the height of foolishness to forbid the foreign trawler to enter our ports; and it is encouraging to know that Peterhead has had the pluck to set aside such a ridiculous rancor and permit German trawlers to discharge their catches without molestation.

Peterhead has been loath to concentrate too much attention upon trawling matters, and not enough upon the other interests. It is now doubtful whether with undue enthusiasm to water, sea, pleasure parties, and golf courses, and collecting those things which might bring increased business to the town. For example, we have a trawling fleet which could be delivering its catches at the home port instead of at Aberdeen.

It is there that my good reason why this cannot be done? It would mean work for a large number of our unemployed people. It is true, doubtless, the fine old crated argument will be advanced: "We are too far from the market," but that is the argument of this class. At the most we are one hour by rail further from the markets than Aberdeen. It is a really vital objection? It is not; and here are two or three reasons to prove our assertion.

First, Peterhead has a much better head with undue enthusiasm to water, sea, pleasure parties, and golf courses, and collecting those things which might bring increased business to the town. For example, we have a trawling fleet which could be delivering its catches at the home port instead of at Aberdeen.
